The philatelic series dedicated to the ninth year of Pope Francis' pontificate refers to chapter VIII of the Encyclical *Fratelli tutti*, where the Holy Father explains the contribution that different religions can give to the construction of a more fraternal world: « The different religions, starting from the recognition of the value of every human person as a creature called to be a son or daughter of God, offer a precious contribution for the construction of fraternity and for the defense of justice in society.

Dialogue between people of different religions is not just done out of diplomacy, courtesy or tolerance. As the Bishops of India have taught, "the objective of dialogue is to establish friendship, peace, harmony and share moral and spiritual values and experiences in a spirit of truth and love"» (FT 271).



Special postage stamp and postmark for emissions Easter of Resurrection MMXXI

The stamp dedicated to Easter 2021 reproduces a work by Vitaliy Shtanko. The Ukrainian artist wanted to represent the moment in which the Risen Lord, on Easter evening, appeared to the eleven apostles who, frightened, were closed in the cenacle, and showing them his hands, feet and side pierced during the passion he asked, "Why do doubts arise in your heart?" (*Luke* 24.38).

This is the question that the Lord also asks us, especially in this time of pandemic, and to us too, like the apostles, He shows His wounds, a sign of God's love. Because as Pope Francis teaches, it is the faithful love of God that helps us to overcome doubts: "Therefore, the deepest teaching that we are called to transmit and the surest certainty to overcome doubts is the love of God with which we have been loved (cf. *1 John* 4:10). A great love, free and given forever" (General Audience of 23 November 2016, Catechesis on the spiritual works of mercy: advising the doubtful).



On 8 December 2020, Pope Francis proclaimed *the Year of Saint Joseph*, which will end on 8 December 2021. With this particular jubilee, the Holy Father wants to celebrate the 150th anniversary of the proclamation of Saint Joseph as Patron of the universal Church and to grow "love towards this great Saint, to be encouraged to implore his intercession and to imitate his virtues and his enthusiasm" (Apostolic Letter, *Patris Corde*).

90th anniversary of the foundation of Vatican Radio
and 160th anniversary of the foundation of "L'Osservatore Romano"

Five years after the establishment of the new Dicastery for Communication, which brought together all the bodies dealing with communication, on the 90th anniversary of the foundation of Vatican Radio and on the 160th anniversary of the foundation of "L'Osservatore Romano", the issuing of a philatelic leaflet gives us the opportunity to reiterate the considerations that the Holy Father expressed in the speech to the Roman Curia for Christmas greetings, on 21 December 2019: "The new culture, marked by factors of convergence and multimedia , needs an adequate response from the Apostolic See in the field of communication. Today, compared to diversified services, the multimedia form prevails, and this also marks the way of conceiving, thinking about and implementing them".



Special postage stamp and postmark for emissions 150th anniversary of the Congregation of Canons Regular of the Immaculate Conception

This year marks the 150th anniversary of the Congregation of Canons Regular of the Immaculate Conception. The founder Dom Gréa (1828-1917) in 1908 remembered this anniversary as a "celebration" for the Church and in the Church: "Today my poor old heart is experiencing a double and triple celebration. I'm sure that overseas you too are partying with me. Feast of our Mother; feast of his humble servant whom the martyr Saint Hadrian dresses with his purple, with his red robe [...] Anniversary also of the definitive foundation of our Congregation with the perpetual profession of its first religious" (Letter from Gréa to Cyprien Casimir and brothers of Callao, 8 September 1908).

live with joy in the love of God and in hope».

The imprint of value represents the meeting between Saint Francis, the poor man of Assisi, and the sultan Malik-al-Kamil, which took place in Egypt in 1219, chosen as the icon of the Encyclical Fratelli tutti, since it synthesizes the attitudes that underlie fraternal relationships:

«Without ignoring the difficulties and dangers, Saint Francis went to meet the Sultan with the same attitude that he demanded from his disciples: that, without denying their own identity, finding themselves "among the Saracens or other infidels [...], they do not quarrels or disputes, but are subject to every human creature for the love of God'" (FT 3).



Special postage stamp and postmark for emissions V centenary of the conversion of Saint Ignatius of Loyola

The special Ignatian jubilee announced for the year 2021 wants to celebrate the 500 years of the conversion of Saint Ignatius of Loyola, an event that marked his life and opened a path to holiness. Iñigo, as the lord of Loyola was called, after the siege of Pamplona, was taken to his hometown to treat the leg wound suffered in the fight. During his convalescence, the future founder of the Society of Jesus entrusts himself to Saint Peter so that he can heal and resume his life following the glory and honors of chivalry.

On the eve of June 29, the apostle's feast day, his condition improved. In this period he asks to be able to read novels of chivalry but in the house there are only the *Vita Christi* of the Carthusian Ludolph of Saxony and a Spanish translation of the *Golden Legend* on the lives of the saints by Giacomo da Varazze. Lacking anything else, Iñigo begins to read them and, gradually, becomes fascinated by the figure of Jesus and the exploits of those who spent their lives to follow him. Thus began his existential journey of conversion, self-taught, paying attention to the affections he felt in his heart: the consolations and desolations. This experience will become the foundation of the discernment of spirits and the principle of the Spiritual Exercises, composed by him.

Special postal note and postmark for issues VIII centenary of the Way of Saint Anthony of Padua

800 years have passed since Saint Anthony of Padua was shipwrecked on the coast of Sicily and since his first meeting with Saint Francis of Assisi. For Fernando Martins de Bulhões, the future Saint Anthony, the choice to become a friar arose from the meeting with some of the first Franciscans, five Italian missionaries leaving for Morocco where they suffered martyrdom. Inflamed by their example, he wanted to follow in their footsteps. He also immediately left for Morocco, but upon arriving in Africa he fell seriously ill. At this point he would have liked to return to Portugal, but in the spring of 1221 a furious storm forced his ship to change course and land in Sicily where he was welcomed by the friars of Messina, who made him regain his lost vigor and announced to him that Fran- Cesco, the founder of the Order, had summoned them to Assisi for the great gathering of all the friars of the time, called the Chapter of the Mats. Antonio then left, traveling up Italy on foot until he reached Assisi, where he met Saint Francis for the first time. Since then, animated by the Spirit, he has made himself known and appreciated as a great man of the Gospel and charity, a friend of God and a friend of men, especially the poorest, so much so that he still remains in everyone's hearts today, known in every corner of the world. with the name of Saint Anthony of Padua.

Stamps and special postal cancellation for issues Europe 2021: National wildlife at risk of extinction

For the creation of the *Europa 2021* series , our attention focused on the Vatican Gardens, a natural habitat of 23 hectares located mainly on the Vatican hill, where the protection of the environment and landscape is observed to safeguard the local fauna and flora . Despite this, wild avifauna represents the most fragile class in this small ecosystem, as it is inserted in a larger environment, such as the city one, where non-native species have found a massive settlement to the detriment of the native ones.

Among these, the wren (*Troglodytes troglodytes*) is difficult to detect in the wooded area of the Vatican Gardens, where it is kept as if in a precious shrine in the cool and humid climate, finding safe shelter and food among the fountains and cavities eroded in the deposits of golden clays of the Vatican hill. This small ground-colored passerine, known as the "woodland elf", camouflages itself among the roots of trees by jumping suddenly in search of worms and insects. This species is increasingly sedentary in this small territory, not only due to the limited anthropic presence, but also due to the recent "biological conversion" of the Gardens, so much so that there is hope for its repopulation.

From the smallest exponent of wild avifauna we move on to the largest present, circling to the "Holy Spirit", the common kestrel (*Falco tinnunculus*), which due to the urbanization of the countryside has moved to urban centres, finding in the City of Vatican an ideal eco-system. Unfortunately, its offspring are sometimes preyed upon and food resources, mainly small sparrows and rodents, are increasingly less available.

Stamps and special postal cancellation for issues V centenary of the birth of Pope Sixtus V

The Postal and Philately Service of the Vatican remembers, on the fifth centenary of his birth, Pope Sixtus V, born Felice Peretti, whose pontificate, despite its short duration (1585-1590) is considered among the most important of the sixteenth century, so strong was the Pontiff's impulse towards the social, financial but above all urban reorganization of Rome.

With the collaboration of the architect Domenico Fontana, Sixtus V resumed and strengthened some projects started by his predecessors, intervening both on a structural, urban and architectural level. He completed the Dome of St. Peter's, designed by Michelangelo, and ordered the expansion of the Vatican Apostolic Library through the construction of the Sistine Hall. He had four grandiose obelisks erected in four different points of the city, thus symbolically uniting them: Piazza San Pietro, Piazza del Popolo, Piazza dell'Esquilino and Piazza San Giovanni in Laterano. Here, less than two months after his settlement, he began excavations for the construction of the new Apostolic Palace, completed in 1589, and had the Loggia of Blessings built.



Series of postcards and special cancellation for issues 50th anniversary of the Paul VI Hall

The 2021 postcard series celebrates the 50th anniversary of the Paul VI Hall, the Vatican auditorium dedicated to general audiences and other events with a large turnout of the faithful. Commonly known as Aula Nervi, from the name of the architect who designed it, it is named after the Pope under whom it was built. In fact, it was Pope Montini who in 1964 commissioned the architect Pier-luigi Nervi to build it, which took place between 1966 and 1971, the year of inauguration.

Located to the left of St. Peter's Basilica, the imposing reinforced concrete construction, with a capacity of 12,000 seats, is illuminated by two enormous polychrome oval windows, created by the Hungarian artist János Hajnal. Inside, the large parabolic vault focuses the public's attention on the stage where the bronze work by Pericle Fazzini depicting *Christ rising from the chaos of death triumphs*, created between 1970 and 1975 under the pontificate of Paul VI, and placed in the hall in 1977. Since then it has served as the backdrop to papal audiences.

The recent restoration, carried out in 2011 by the Vatican Governorate and under the control of the Directorate of the Vatican Museums, has returned the original light and splendor to the bronze complex. In 2008, the large photovoltaic system installed on the roof also came into operation, which thanks to its 2,400 photovoltaic modules is able to cover a quarter of the energy needs of the classroom and neighboring buildings.



This year, Budapest will host the 52nd International Eucharistic Congress from 7 to 12 September, initially scheduled for September 2020 and postponed due to the pandemic emergency.

During his speech to the Plenary of the Pontifical Committee for International Eucharistic Congresses, on 10 November 2018, Pope Francis explained that celebrating a Eucharistic Congress in a large and modern European city like Budapest "in which the Gospel and the forms of belonging religious have become marginal, it means collaborating with the grace of God to spread, through prayer and action, a Eucharistic culture, that is, a way of thinking and operating based on the Sacrament but perceptible even beyond ecclesial belonging".

The logo created for the Congress, a representation of the theme chosen for the Congress itself inspired by Psalm 87 "All my sources are in you" recurs in both stamps making up the series. The spring that flows from the representation of the Eucharist is divided into four branches, symbolizing the four rivers of Eden and the spread of the Good News throughout the world through the four evangelists. Its water flows into the river, depicted as a wave to recall the incessant evangelizing activity of the Church. Just as the Danube crosses different countries and peoples during its journey, connecting them, so the Eucharist unites Christians of different cultures and languages of the European continent, in the brotherhood of the children of God.

Dante Alighieri, through his most famous poem, showed himself to be a "prophet of hope and witness to the thirst for the infinite inherent in the heart of man", who "much better than many others was able to express, with the beauty of poetry, the depth of mystery of God and love". Thus in the Apostolic Letter *Candor Lucis eternae* Pope Francis, referring to the Divine Comedy, pays homage to Dante, inviting us to grasp the relevance and universality of his testimony of faith, to retrace with him the stages of that long journey of discovery and experimentation of our humanity, from overcoming the dark forests that cloud the causal senses



Special postal note and postmark for issues 450th anniversary of Caravaggio's birth

In 1571, Michelangelo Merisi, known as Caravaggio, was born in Milan, a brilliant artist with a restless and tormented personality characterized, like his painting, by contrasts of light and shadow. His troubled life, made up of dark and gloomy hues, never compromised his pictorial genius, which indeed drew strength and nourishment from it. Although soon famous and contested by the most powerful men in Italy, Caravaggio drew his inspiration from the slums and margins of society. In the artist's works the religious theme is combined with the social one since the divine is revealed by the poor.

The Vatican leaflet celebrating the anniversary reproduces the *Martyrdom of Saint Matthew* created between 1600 and 1601 and kept in the Contarelli chapel in the Church of San Luigi dei Francesi in Rome. Caravaggio signs this work by portraying himself in the background of the dramatic representation, as if protruding from a wing of a theater scene. In this dramatization the executioner is placed in the center of the picture in the act of killing the Holy Evangelist, who is lying beneath him with his gaze turned towards the sky in the direction of the angel who offers him the palm, a sign of the prize that awaits him in heaven. This composition in chiasmus shows how "God's weakness is stronger than men" (1 Cor 1:25).



The Vatican aerogram celebrates this year the fourth centenary of the death of San Roberto Belarmino, Jesuit theologian, writer, professor and rector of the Roman College, of which the Pontifical Gregorian University is the successor. Grandson of Pope Marcellus II, he showed a strong religious inclination since he was a child, attracted more by the things of God than by the vanities of life. He received an excellent humanistic education and was welcomed into the Society of Jesus in 1560. Ordained a priest in 1570, he was called as professor at the Roman College for the Chair of "Apologetics".

Despite the burdensome offices carried out with zeal and competence, including those of consultor of the Holy Office and rector of the College of Penitentiaries of St. Peter's Basilica, St. Robert always continued to dedicate himself to preaching and catechesis with the typical passion and essentiality of Ignatian education.



The international reply coupon is a postal security card introduced on 1 October 1907 in implementation of the resolutions of the VI Universal Postal Congress of Rome in 1906. The Vatican City State, member of the UPU since 1 June 1929, joined to the sales service starting from 2009.

Over the years, in addition to its primary social function as a valuable card capable of facilitating international postal communication, the reply voucher has also taken on a collectible value.







The voucher, which bears the name of the location where the XXVII Universal Postal Congress has just concluded, is dedicated to the theme "Preserving the ecosystem - Protecting the climate". The winning entry in the specific competition organized by the International Bureau of the Universal Postal Union, open to all member countries, was the one presented by Belarus.

The new *«Abidjan»* model voucher can be converted in all countries of the Universal Postal Union until 31 December 2025 into a stamp equivalent to the minimum amount of an unregistered priority item destined for abroad.

Christmas night in the year 1121 marks the foundation of the Abbey of Prémontré, which took place with the solemn profession of Saint Norbert and his 40 companions.

According to Latin patrology, the place where to build the abbey was indicated by God himself. Wanting to find land where Norbert could carry out his reform project, the bishop of Laon, Barthélemy de Jur, took the founding saint to the southern part of the diocese, in the Saint-Gobain massif, where there was a small church dedicated to Saint John the Baptist, the only witness of an ancient community of hermits. After spending a night in prayer, Norbert said to the bishop: "My Lord and Father, I want to stay here. I have identified the place that the Lord has destined for me. Here will be my home and my rest. Many men will find salvation there. However, this chapel will not be the center, but the building will be built on the other side of the valley. This night a group of men dressed in white appeared in a dream and were processionally going around the valley, carrying silver crosses, candelabras and censers." Thus originated the order of Premonstratensian Canons Regular, whose rule was approved by Pope Honorius II in 1126.

The twentieth anniversary of the post-synodal Apostolic Exhortation *Ecclesia in Oceania* of the Holy Father John Paul II, on Jesus Christ and the peoples of Oceania, *"following his way, proclaiming his truth, living his life"*, donates to Vatican philately the opportunity to begin an ideal pilgrimage around the earth in preparation for the 2025 Jubilee.

The pilgrimage will start from Oceania and cross the five continents. This itinerary will be marked by the six-monthly issue of a leaflet for each geographical area, to conclude in the second issue of 2024. Special postal cancellation Appeal from Pope Francis and religious leaders to COP26

In view of the 26th edition of the United Nations conference on climate change, called the "Conference of the Parties", which was held in Glasgow (United Kingdom) from 31 October to 12 November 2021, the Holy Father Francis, on 4 October 2021, of the first anniversary of the Encyclical *Fratelli tutti* dedicated to human brotherhood, brought together in the Hall of Blessing scientists, experts and religious leaders (among these, the great imam of al-Azhar, Ahmad al-Tayyeb, and the patriarch of Constantinople, Bartolomeo I) for the meeting *"Faith and Science. Towards Cop* 26".

During the meeting, a joint appeal was signed for the Conference to provide effective responses and push for the adoption of behaviors and actions modeled on "interdependence" and "co-responsibility" to counteract the "seeds of conflicts" that cause wounds in environment and in the human person.




